

Cookies policy

- 1) Cookies refer to electronic information that may be stored on user's device and enables the website to remember the user's actions and preferences over a period of time.
- 2) Our website may employ cookies for identification of the user's hardware and software, including your browser, to customize your preferences, and to keep records of your actions on the website.
- 3) We use the following categories of cookies:
 - a) Authorization cookies, which allow you to log in and use your account;
 - b) Notification cookies, which allow the website to display notices and messages to you;
 - c) Analytics cookies, which may also include web beacons and pixel tags. We may also use third party website analytics tools (for example, Google Analytics) that employ cookies to collect certain information that cannot be used for personal identification purposes, concerning your use of our websites, e.g. website address links, page views, and browser types.
- 4) Enabling cookies is not strictly required to enable the primary functions of our website, but it will provide you with a better browsing experience. You may control, delete, or disable cookies by changing your browser settings at any time. However, disabling cookies may impair some of the website's and services functionality.
- 5) Cookies are not used to identify you personally and the data collected on your browsing behavior on our website is kept under fully secure conditions. Cookies are not used for any purpose other than those described herein.
